



10. What did the glory of one angel do to the guards at Christ's tomb? Mt. 28:1-4

This point cannot be overlooked! When a single angel appeared to some of the toughest, fiercest, war-hardened men alive, they trembled for fear and fell "as dead men." Imagine, then, what the result will be when all the angels of heaven, along with the Father and the Son, are visibly seen coming in the clouds!

11. What sequence of events does the Bible list for Christ's coming? 2 Thes. 1:7-10

Note that when Jesus is revealed, the wicked will "in that day" be destroyed and the righteous will be glorified.

12. What does the Bible say to indicate that the tribulation is prior to Christ's return? 2 Thes. 2:1-3, 8; Rev. 16:15

The Bible says that the day of Christ's return will not come until the antichrist is revealed and is actively at work, only to be destroyed by the brightness of Christ's coming.

13. What does the Bible say about Jesus coming as a thief? 1 Thes. 5:1-3; 2 Pet. 3:10-13; Mt. 24:44.

Note that the term "as a thief" does not refer to the method of Christ's coming, but the manner of His coming. In other words, Christ is not coming to "steal" people silently away to heaven; rather, He will come unexpectedly. We have already learned that the manner is literal, visible, and audible.

14. When Jesus talks about one being taken, and another left, he said it would be just like in the days of who? Lk. 17:26-36

15. In the days of Lot or Noah, did anyone get a "second chance" after the destruction came? Lk. 17:27, 29.

In the days of Noah, the flood was not a secret! In fact, Noah had been preaching that it would come for 120 years. But the flood was a surprise to those who had rejected Noah's warning. In that day, those who believed God were saved, and those who didn't were destroyed. Likewise, in Lot's day, the fire and brimstone that rained down on Sodom and Gomorrah was no secret, but it was a surprise to the wicked inhabitants of Sodom. And there was no "second chance" for either those who lived in Noah's day, or those who lived in Lot's. Destruction and salvation came in one day.

16. Who does the Bible say Jesus will appear to the second time? Heb. 9:28; 2 Tim. 4:8.

Jesus is coming again for those who are eagerly waiting and anticipating His return, to those who "love His appearing." Are you eagerly waiting for Him? Do you want to be ready when He comes? The give your heart to Him again today!
